

PRICES FOR FIRING SERVICES :

* We fire by volume of the shelf. All work must not exceed 6 inches tall.

- Bisque firing = \$10 per shelf or (\$2.50 per quarter shelf)
- Glazing firing = \$15 per shelf or (\$5 per quarter shelf)
- Full Electric Bisque Kiln = \$50 Full Electric Glaze Kiln = \$70
- Gas or Salt/Soda Kiln = \$50 per shelf or (\$12.50 per quarter shelf)

A NOTE TO OUR CUSTOMERS:

Ceramics is exciting yet occasionally embraces unpredictability. Knowing and understanding your materials, clay type, firing temperatures, and glazing techniques is key in making the most of your creations. While we handle your pieces with utmost care during the firing process, certain factors remain beyond our control. The Clay Co-op is not responsible for a piece cracking, breaking, exploding or any other type of unsatisfactory result after firing. Damages to kiln and kiln shelves due to melting glaze or other materials incur more fees. Kilns are notoriously unpredictable. Should an accidental firing occur and the kiln is responsible for damage or destruction of work, you will be notified and the work will be refired free of charge. The Clay Co-op does not take any responsibility for work that goes missing. It is your responsibility to pick up your work in a timely manner.

FIRING SERVICE TERMS & CONDITIONS :

- All work must be clearly stamped with your maker's mark. Unmarked work will not be accepted. •
- All work must be 100% dry when placed on the shelves. Wet greenware will not be accepted.
- The base of your work must be free from glaze (underglaze is OK), otherwise it will not be fired. Please note, if your piece does stick to the kiln shelf due to glaze running, you will be responsible for the repair/replacement of the kiln shelf.
 - Work with overly thick application of glaze or layered glazes may be rejected.
 - We will not fire solid or extremely thick pieces of work as they can explode in the kiln.
 - Hollow work must have a hole.
 - If a kiln shelf is damaged due to your work, you will be charged a \$20 cleaning fee.
 - If a kiln shelf is ruined to the point where it cannot be used again, you will be charged for the cost of replacing that shelf.
 - If your work damages the interior of the kiln, you are required to pay a fine based on the severity of the damage determined by the manager.
 - You are responsible for any damage your work causes to our kilns and/or kiln shelves.

I UNDERSTAND THAT:

- I am responsible for clearly identifying my work
- I must photograph my work when dropping off
- If I don't pick up my work within 30 days of the date it has been fired, it will be discarded. I agree to pay for any damaged shelves and/ or damage to the kiln caused by my work.
